To ensure your eligibility for a regulatory examination you must contact **Marine Services, Department of Planning, Transport, and Infrastructure (DPTI)** to have your pre-requisites, including sea time, assessed and be given approval of eligibility authority for examination. DPTI will charge you a fee for this service.
